EVERY BODY

Not Standing / Alexander Vantournhout

This time. Alexander Vantournhout and Emmi Väisänen draw on our everyday gestures to create their performance.

By deconstructing and reinventing our everyday movements - a handshake, a stroll as a couple, the way we cling to handrails on public transport - in three tableaux, they create a sensible analysis that grows in complexity to form a hypnotic dance each time. The connection between bodies is a constant feature in this uncompromising investigation, forcing the two dancers to work in complete complicity. The upshot is a frenzied virtuosity from which a tantalising sensuality emanates.

Alexander Vantournhout studied cyr wheel and juggling at ESAC (Ecole Supérieure des Arts du Cirque) and contemporary dance at P.A.R.T.S. in Brussels.

Alexander Vantournhout's physical language bears the influences of a varied education and working circumstances. However, it is marked by two constants: his search for the creative and kinetic potential in physical limitation, and the relationship or boundary between performer and object.

Founder of the Not Standing company, he is the author of several pieces including Caprices (2014) and, in collaboration with Bauke Lievens, the solo ANECKXANDER (2015) and the duo Raphaël (2017). His first piece for four performers, Red Haired Men, followed shortly afterwards. With Through the Grapevine (2020). Alexander Vantournhout returns to the duet format. The body is reintroduced in a very pure way and the performance dives into the creative and kinetic potential of physical limitations. In Contre-jour (2021), Alexander takes on the role of choreographer for the first time and gives the floor to a group of five performers from various backgrounds: dance, musical, theatre, circus, etc.. In 2022, he returns solo on stage with VanThorhout. Foreshadow (2023), a creation with eight performers, was presented for the first time at Julidans in Amsterdam, and every body, his latest creation, was presented in October 2024.

Aiming to improve body intelligence, **Not Standing** creates, produces, distributes, and communicates Alexander Vantournhout's unique hybrid movement art to a variety of audiences, across national borders and disciplines.

Not Standing uses the artistic work of Alexander Vantournhout to tell something about the human body, about movement and about physicality in the most fundamental way and aspires to increase body sensitivity for everyone who participates in its activities.

Not Standing embraces limits as a challenge. What is impossible for one individual is made possible with the help of another person and/or an object.

Cooperation is essential to overcome physical limitations in the artistic trajectory as well as on an organisational level.

Continuity and sustainability are central in both (labour) relations and expanded/collaborative trajectories, in securing and showing the repertory and in the relationship with an ever-growing audience.

Generosity-towards each other, towards the public, and towards the world-is a core value. Sharing knowledge and passing on a broadened vision of the body are paramount. **Not Standing**'s unique language of movement generates meaning and resonates outside the arts.

Not Standing does not think in pigeonholes or in categories. It crosses the boundaries of disciplines and creates a unique and hybrid movement art. Contemporary dance is expanded through cross-fertilisation in an open and horizontal organisation characterised by a lasting commitment that can be continually strengthened.
